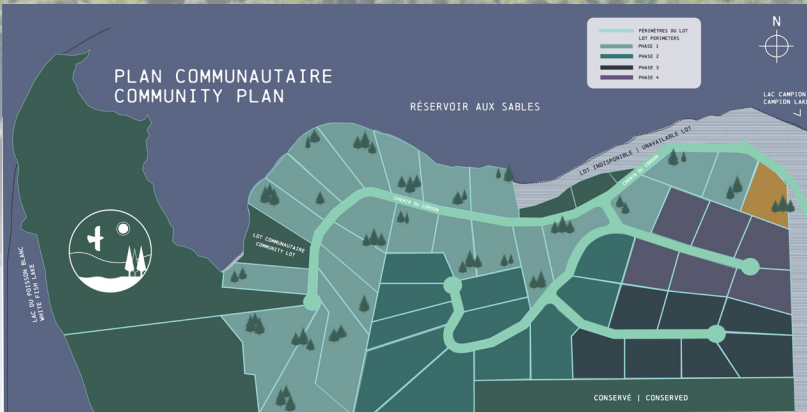


FALCON RIDGE | LOT 23



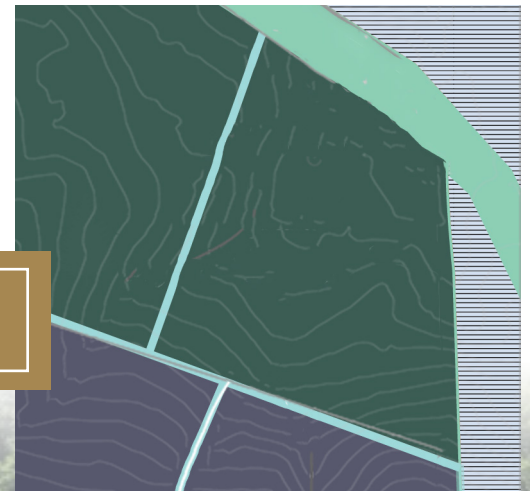

Falcon Ridge is home to the large-flowered uvularia (*Uvularia grandiflora*), a plant that has been designated as a vulnerable species. This plant blooms very early in the spring. It is a victim of its beauty and is commercialized as a garden ornament. This herbaceous plant has yellow flowers that hang like bells at the end of the stem. It is found exclusively in maple-hickory, basswood hickory and basswood, especially in the Outaouais.

This lot is located within the northern horseshoe of the property, near the community entrance. This 1.5 acre lot, across from the waterfront properties and in close proximity to the water, offers beautiful seasonal views of the lake.
