Did you know that bears are fond of the beech trees in the fall? Black bears recognize the beech tree as a good source of high quality food. Numerous red squirrels and chipmunks can be seen and heard. From a wildlife perspective, the Habitat Quality Index (HQI) is diverse and interesting.
